Suitability Key: 1=day trip, picnicking only; 2=Brownie Girl Scouts or inexperienced campers at any age: 3=younger Junior Girl Scouts and up learning basic skills; 4=older Junior Girl Scouts and up or girls with good skills; 5=girls acquiring advanced skills who want to rough it.

For safety and security reasons, the overnight unit capacities must be adhered to. If an emergency occurs and evacuation is necessary, our Site Manager has to rely on the number of people presented at check-in. Unit capacities will be enforced. Please plan ahead so that your troop meets the guidelines listed here.

Cancellations/Refunds: If a troop cancels at least 14 days prior to their camp date, the troop **will receive a refund minus a 20% cancellation fee**. If a troop cancels with less than 14 days' notice OR if a troop is a "no show" without cancelling, **the troop will forfeit the full fee.** To be eligible for a refund the troop must cancel by contacting **Customer Care**.
