

## Cookie Booth Etiquette Pledge

Since Cookie Booths provide an excellent opportunity to increase public awareness of the Girl Scout Organization, it is imperative that proper etiquette and behavior be displayed by everyone (girls and adults) at all cookie booths.

- 1. Always represent GSTOP with pride, following the Girl Scout Promise and Law.
- 2. Adults should never leave Girl Scouts alone at a booth and at least one registered background checked adult should always be at the booth.
- 3. Girl Scouts should always wear a Girl Scout shirt, sash, vest, and/or membership pin while participating in a cookie booth.
- 4. If your troop is scheduled for a booth, please arrive 15 minutes before to set-up and always take down your booth at the assigned time.
- 5. Take all of your trash, including empty cookies cases. Be sure not to leave anything behind.
- 6. Don't forget to bring all of your booth decorations and sales materials.
- 7. Food and drinks should not be consumed during a booth sale nor should talking or texting on a cell phone.
- 8. "Please" and "Thank you" goes a long way, even if the customer says no to purchasing cookies.
- 9. Be sure to be a sister to every Girl Scout, including girls in other troops who have booths before and/or after you.

The person in charge should have the booth sale confirmation email with them.
